Pastor's Corner

Baptism and Confirmation

44 While Peter was still speaking these things, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the Word. 45 The circumcised believers who had accompanied Peter were astounded that the gift of the Holy Spirit should have been poured out on the Gentiles also, 46 for they could hear them speaking in tongues and glorifying God. Then Peter responded, 47 "Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people, who have received the Holy Spirit even as we have?" 48 He ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. (Acts 10: 44-48)

Notice how the Holy Spirit came to all the people in Cornelius' house even before they were baptized. Notice too, how Peter said: "Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people..." (Acts 10:47) Peter opens the doors of the church now to the gentiles to fulfill Jesus' command: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. (Mt 28:19) As the Church gathered around the Peter grows so to in our modern age that united around Christ's vicar we may experience the full effects of the Kingdom of God on earth as it is in heaven.

Pray for our young people who are to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, that they may use the gifts that they are given to spread God's word and do the work of the Saints in our day and age!


