The Rosary is prayed on Sundays at 7:45 am before Mass; also at 10:45 am. Mother Mary, we are thankful that you intercede on our behalf.

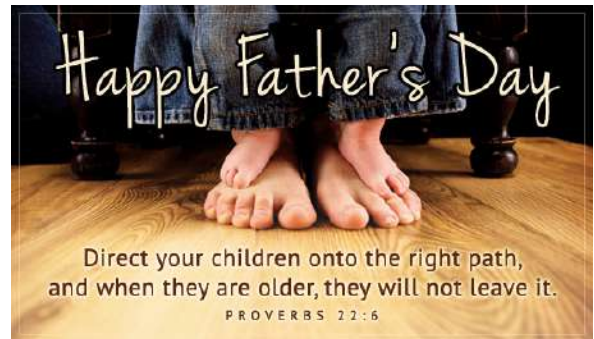
Prayer Intentions for June 2018:


