**The Solemnity of the
Most Holy Body and Blood Of
Jesus Christ**

“On the night he was betrayed, he took bread and gave you thanks and praise. He broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said:

Take this, all of you, and eat it: this is my body which will be given up for you.

When Supper was ended, he took the cup. Again he gave you thanks and praise, gave the cup to his disciples, and said:

Take this, all of you, and drink from it: this is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven.

Do this in memory of me.

During these words, that we hear Sunday after Sunday from the third Eucharistic Prayer, God breaks into our reality. The priest, quoting sacred scripture (see Matthew 26:26-28; Mk14:22-26; Luke 22:19-20; 1 Cor 11:23-25) in obedience to Christ and His church opens us up to the power of God. It is during these sacred words that God in His mystical way changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. This fulfills Christ's prophetic statement at the end of the Gospel of Matthew: Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Mt 28: 18-20)


