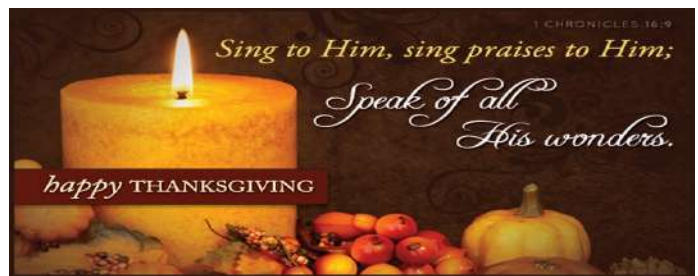
**Divine Mercy**
