An excerpt from the Diary of St. Faustina (Diary 699)

On one occasion, I heard Jesus say these words to me: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Font of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates, through which graces flow, are open. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even through its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it human or angelic, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity.

ABC's of Mercy

Ask for His mercy - God wants us to approach Jesus in prayer, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy upon us and upon the whole world.

Be merciful to others - God wants us to receive His mercy and extend mercy (Love and forgiveness) to others just as He does to us.

Complete trust in Jesus - God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust in Him. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Prepare for Divine Mercy and participate in our Novena of Mercy starting on Good Friday!
